The Montana Seed Growers Association (MSG) is proud to announce the annual MSGA Scholarship Program, supporting the next generation of agricultural leaders in Montana. This scholarship recognizes students who demonstrate a passion for seed production, plant science, or agricultural advancement, and who are committed to the success and sustainability of Montana's agricultural community.

Deadline: 05/01/2026

Award Amount: \$500 - \$2,000

#### Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a resident of Montana or have strong ties to the state's agricultural community or seed production.
- Be enrolled or planning to enroll in an accredited post-secondary institution (EX: four-year universities, community/technical colleges, or vocational/trade schools.)
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Demonstrate a commitment to Montana agriculture, particularly seed certification, or crop development; and demonstrate a commitment to bettering Montana's agricultural and rural communities.
- Preference given to:
  - MSGA members or dependents of members.
  - Students studying agriculture, plant or crop science, seed technology, agronomy, horticulture, agricultural education, agriculture related trades, or related fields that benefit Montana's agricultural and rural communities.

#### Required Materials:

- Completed MSGA Scholarship Application Form.
- A one-page essay addressing:
  - Your background in Montana agriculture.
  - How the scholarship will support educational and professional goals.
  - How you plan to contribute to the seed industry or Montana agricultural communities.
- Current transcript (official or unofficial).
- One or two letter(s) of recommendation. (EX: from a teacher, professor, academic advisor, community leader, employer, agricultural leader, MSGA member, etc.)
- Resume highlighting work experience, extracurricular involvement, volunteerism, or leadership in agricultural organizations (EX: FFA, 4-H, collegiate ag. clubs).
