You, the citizens of Circle by majority vote at the primary election held June 5, 1984, mandated the formation of a Local Government Review Study Commission to review the government of the Town of Circle and to submit recommendations thereon.

We, the members of that Local Government Review Study Commission, hereby submit the following final report:

We reviewed Circle's existing Charter form of government in addition to the other forms available to the towns and cities of Montana.


We advertised and held both bi-monthly commission meetings (open to the public) and two public meetings as required by law, the purpose of which was to gather input from the public.

Due to the lack of public participation we personally contacted various town officials and members of the electorate.

After having completed the government review process in accordance with Montana State law, we recommend no change in the existing Commission-Executive (Council-Mayor) form of self governing powers under provisions of the Charter as adopted by majority vote November 2, 1976.
