4-H Building Cleaning Guidelines

Club Cleaning Responsibilities:

- 1. Entry ways: vacuum rugs, wipe off door handles.
- 2. Main area: wipe down tables and chairs (those set up and the ones on the storage carts).
- 3. Sweep and use the floor scrubber on all flooring (see directions on machine or watch demonstration: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7fejG2W74Bk</u>).
- 4. Kitchen: Clean sinks. Wipe down counters (top & front) including the kitchen island, inside and outside of microwave, appliance (fridge, stove) fronts and handles and stove top.
- 5. Bathrooms: sweep & mop floors, clean sinks, toilets, mirrors, and drinking fountain. Wipe off door handles.
- 6. Empty <u>all</u> garbage cans and replace can liners. Take garbage out to the large dumpster outside of the building.
- 7. Closets and storage area are to be kept organized.

Leaving the building:

- 1. All chairs, materials and equipment should be returned to the location they were in upon entry. Do not remove chairs, tables, or any other items unless authorized by the Extension office.
- 2. Heat should be set at 65 degrees. Air conditioning should be set at 70 degrees. Remember to check both thermostats.
- 3. Check that all lights are off and all doors are locked.
- 4. Return the building key to the Extension office.

**Cleaning supplies are in the closet nearest the kitchen area and in the backroom. Please notify the office if supplies are low.
