Reinforce university-wide training requirements.

Basic MSU Policy Workflow

How do Policy changes start?

- University-wide concern.
- Legal or regulatory requirements.
- Regular reviews every 3 years.

Anyone can bring forth a concern that may involve Policy.

Basic MSU Policy Workflow

1. Review with Policy owners.
2. Creation of work group.
3. Review by related supervisors and VPs.
4. Review by other stakeholders, governing bodies.
5. Review by the Executive Team.
6. Presented for first reading at University Council.
7. Second reading at University Council and possible vote to adopt.

Student Field Trips

Major updates include:

- Establishing the travel radius to constitute a “Student Trip.”
 - 25 miles.
- Outlining requirements including Trip Coordinator, Sponsoring Unit Contact Person, and other safety standards.

Information Updates: Grad Council

- Graduation applications for Spring graduation are due tomorrow (Feb. 5) - students have a MyMSU component and advisors have a Degreeworks-note component
- Update that the Grad School has been able to work with VP-RED and various advisors to ensure that no grad students have lost funding due to federal funding cuts or shifts this semester.
- Graduate Student Leadership Counsel is collaborating with MSU Legal to clarify a framework for TAs on what to do if ICE enters their classrooms.
- Discussed the need for systems responses to systems problems, rather than relying on individual responses, and thinking more broadly about what emergency response training faculty are receiving.
