Information Updates: Regents Professor Policy

- “The purpose of this policy is to establish the criteria and nominating procedures for the award of the rank of Regents Professor to Montana State University faculty members, in accordance with Board of Regents personnel policy.”
- “Montana State University may recommend granting the rank of Regents Professor to a faculty member who:
 - is a tenured full professor, with at least five years of tenure-track service at Montana State University,
 - exhibits extraordinary and sustained distinction in scholarly activity that has demonstrably advanced the quality of the University’s teaching, research, and service missions,
 - has achieved clear and convincing evidence of earned national/international recognition outside of Montana State University,
 - will serve as an exemplary scholar and mentor for faculty colleagues, students, and public constituencies.”

 - [Reporting Suspected Legal, Regulatory, or Policy Violations](#) (OneMSU)
 - *Encourages reporting of suspected legal, regulatory, or policy violations, describes reporting procedures, and protects good-faith reporter from reprisal or retaliation.*
- Approved policies:
 - Student Safety Questionnaire Policy
 - *Deals with student applicants who could present an unreasonable risk to the safety and welfare of the campus community*
 - Revised Alcohol, Drug, and Tobacco Policy
 - *Combines alcohol, tobacco, and drug policies--generally follows current rules and procedures.*
