

**Using DegreeWorks  
To Track a Student's Program of Study**

The Graduate School requires students to submit a Program of Study. Doctoral students must submit before the end of their third semester and/or prior to sitting for the comprehensive exam and Master's students must submit before the end of their second semester and/or prior to sitting for the comprehensive exam.

The program of study puts in place the student's committee members and outlines courses, research, exams and other requirements to be completed in fulfillment of the degree. **DegreeWorks will display program of study information for students who have submitted a new program of study or changes to an existing one on or after May 15, 2014.**

## Using DegreeWorks To Track a Student's Program of Study

- Find a student by entering their GID or searching by name. Program of Study information is stored as a worksheet so make sure you are on the **Worksheets** tab.
- Make sure Format = **Student View**. (Hit **View** when switching between different formats.) Hit **Process New** to see information that has been added since the last time the record was opened.
