

Hello and welcome to another how-to tutorial. Today we will be going over the new student login format and how student usernames differ from student worker and graduate assistant usernames.

To do this, I'm going to take you through the process of logging in to your MSU email account.

Start by going to montana.edu and clicking on "students" in the top left corner of the screen.

Once on the student resource page, navigate to the "email" tab towards the top of your screen and click in.

Here you will be given two choices and some email account information resources. It's also where that difference between accounts mentioned at the beginning of this tutorial comes into play.

For all regular student needs, you will log in using the "MSU Student" email login button. You will use your NetID@student.montana.edu username and associated password.

For all student worker and graduate assistant needs, you will log in using the "student worker/graduate assistantship" email login button. You will use your NetID@student.montana.edu username and associated password.

You will then be taken to another, more familiar login page. Here I'm showing you the regular student login process where I'm using my NetID@student.montana.edu username.

You'll then type in your NetID password.

If this is your first time logging into an MSU application that day, you will go through the DUO authentication process.

Congrats, you're logged in! Remember: student workers and graduate assistants use their NetID@msu.montana.edu username for work accounts, and NetID@student.montana.edu for personal accounts.
